TENDER for CALDWELL MARINA HABITAT RESTORATION PROJECT - PHASE 2

Tenders will be received by the Essex Region Conservation Authority, 360 Fairview Avenue West, Essex, Ontario, N8M 1Y6 until **TWO (2:00:59) p.m., local time, Thursday, October 26, 2017**, for the Caldwell Marina Habitat Restoration Project – Phase 2 – Site Development in the Town of Leamington, Ontario. The work to be completed under this Tender generally consists of the following:

- **Removal and disposal of existing steel sheet pile walls;**
- **Construction of armour stone revetment;**
- **Construction of habitat features including excavation and grading; and**
- **Site restoration of topsoil.**

Envelopes shall be sealed and plainly marked: "Tender for Caldwell Marina Habitat Restoration Project – Phase 2"; Tender No. 17-004" with the name and address of the tenderer.

- **and, miscellaneous gravel trail works.**
